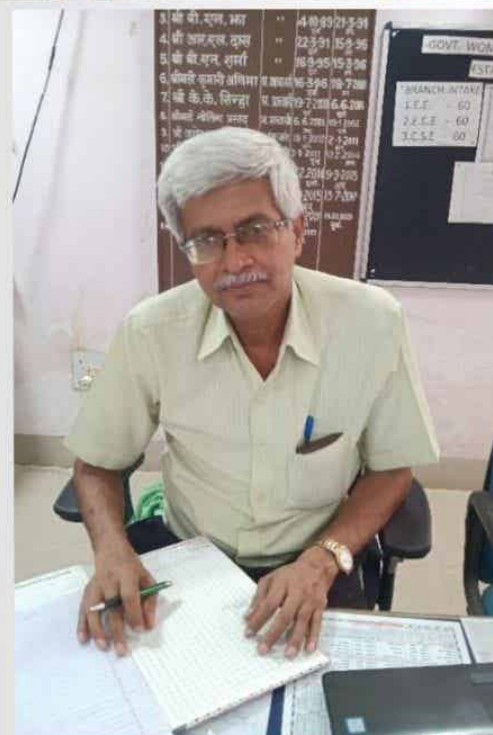

## ROAD SAFETY PROGRAM

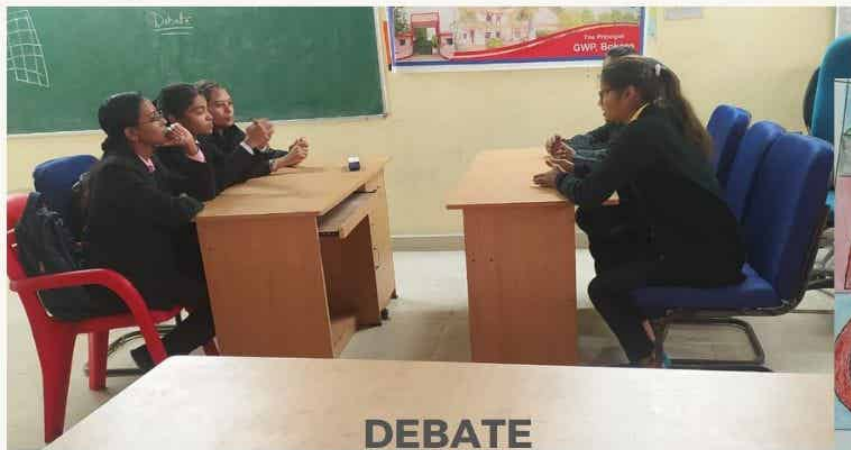
